

10 ERS TIPS TO REMEMBER

1

Read the ERS scale and the All About book that is relevant to your classroom.

2

Be sure each classroom has a current schedule and dated lesson plan posted inside the classroom.

3

Make sure each classroom has fresh, proper sanitizing and soapy-water solution.

4

Stock each classroom with soap, paper towels, Kleenex, and bathroom tissue.

5

Classroom display should include child-initiated artwork, diverse pictures, and colorful posters.

6

Check fall zones on playground for sufficient ground cover (9 inches).

7

Be sure that toys and materials are accessible to children.

8

Don't forget to have many meaningful conversations with children (including babies) during play, learning, and routine care.

9

Appropriate supervision during play, learning, and routine care (eating, sleeping, toileting, diapering, etc.) is critical.

10

Be mindful of proper hand washing, sanitizing, and diapering procedures!!!
